1	What you need	i) Own plates/food container, drinking bottles/mug & cutleries ii) Wear GREEN color t-shirt i) Stationeries - Pencils, sharper & eraser ii) Reference materials - dictionary, thesaurus, refreshments, Internet, etc iii) Snacks & drinks iv) Medication / energy booster v) Creativity & thinking cap
2	Preparation	i) Sleep Early – Be Physically & Mentally Fit ii) Be easy on the breakfast iii) Get the reference materials available and organised.
3	Route Questions	i) The questions given are in the form of sentence(s), riddle(s), phrase(s) or pictorial(s). Each sentence(s) or line(s) will be supported by 1 or more indicator(s) to tip-off the type of question and type of solution. ii) All questions are ONLY in English or Bahasa Melayu. iii) Answers can be found within the sector as indicated in the tulip and are clearly visible. iv) All the answers are in sequence within the sector indicated. v) Answers can be found on permanent signboards and signage only - NOT banners, buntings, bills or stickers. vi) Answers need to be written clearly and in full. Where 2 languages (English & Bahasa Melayu) exist, any one is acceptable except if the answer is specific to that language. vii) Tips: What You See Is What You Write (WYSIWYW). E.g. KEDAI SERBANEKA NEWSPLUS KAWASAKI @ MOSES MOTOR ENTERPRISE

	General knowledge	<p>A direct question relating to history, sports, politics, culture, film, music, etc</p> <p>Q: BBC + CNN + Al Jazeera +..... A: KEDAI SERBANEKA NEWSPLUS</p> <p>Indicator: <i>None</i> BBC, CNN, Al Jazeera = News channels + = Plus</p>
	Charades / Combination	<p>Combine 2 or more words to form another word for the answer</p> <p>Q: Ibu gembira menjamu di sini. A: RESTORAN MARIA</p> <p>Indicator: <i>None</i> Ibu = Ma Gembira = Ria Menjambu = Restoran, café business</p>
	Insertion	<p>Putting 1 or more words into another word(s) to form the answer.</p> <p>Q: Awas! Kelihatan di dalam kaki di sini. Apa dia dan di mana? A: KAWASAKI @ MOSES MOTOR ENTERPRISE</p> <p>Indicator: <i>Di dalam</i> Put AWAS into KAKI = KAWASAKI</p>
	Deletion	<p>Removing 1 or more words into another word(s) to form the answer</p> <p>Q: I left for an emergency call A: Pejabat Urusan iSOS</p> <p>Indicator: <i>Left</i> Remove "I" from the word iSOS. The remaining "SOS" means an emergency call.</p>
	Return / Reverse	<p>Form another word in reversed order</p> <p>Q: RATS returning to be treated here A: KLINIK STAR</p> <p>Indicator: <i>Returning</i> RATS in the reversed order is STAR To be treated here = Clinic, hospital, pharmacy business</p>
	Initial / End	<p>Pick the first or last letter of the words</p> <p>Q: Pada mulanya, parti pembangkang undi mereka... A: PPUM</p> <p>Indicator: <i>Pada mulanya</i> Take the first letter each from the following words.</p>

	Homophones / Sounds like	<p>Word(s) with similar pronunciation (sound alike) but with different spelling(s)</p> <p>Q: Sounds like no one winning here. A: SYARIKAT LOO SENG</p> <p>Indicator: <i>Sounds like</i> No winning = Losing</p>
	Container	<p>A word inside another word or in between across few words</p> <p>Q: A Reds fan found in here for a vision. A: PUSAT CERMIN MATA OK OPTICAL</p> <p>Indicator: <i>Found in</i> Reds fan = Liverpool fan = Kop Vision = Optical business</p>
	Spotting	To spot the exact word(s) or sentence on the signboard.
	Synonym	<p><i>Eg.</i> Road – Street, way, etc Sports – Games Red – Cherry, crimson Companion – Friend, buddy, cohort</p>
	To replace a word or words with similar meaning	
	Anagram	<p>Word(s) to be rearranged to form another word(s)</p> <p>Q: Eh! Angels disguised!! Tell me where. A: LEHENGAS @ WIZE CREATION SDN BHD</p> <p>Indicator: <i>Disguised</i> EH ANGELS → LEHENGALS</p>
6	Treasure questions	<p>i) Treasure questions will either be a set of riddles or pictorial that needs to be solved, purchased and handed in at the Finish Control.</p> <p>ii) The answer need to be written in full (brand + item name + flavor) in the answer sheet. <i>E.g.</i></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • 6 X DUTCH LADY CHOCOLATE MILK 250ml • MISTER POTATO CRISPS BBQ FLAVOUR LIMITED EDITION
7	Sample treasure question	<p>The nickname of a former US President we know well, And from that place comes this lovely belle, Just bring me a 6-pack of 250mL Of chocolate flavour only for me to dwell.</p> <p>A: 6 X DUTCH LADY CHOCOLATE MILK 250ml</p> <p>Former US President = Ronald Reegan = Dutch Belle = Lady</p>
8	Notes	<p>i) Write down your Team Name and Team Number clearly on EVERY page of the Route, Treasure and Challenge sheets.</p> <p>ii) Be cool and calm. Don't lose it.</p> <p>iii) Time management</p> <p>iv) Think out of the box</p> <p>v) Keep road safety in mind.
